




How Sweden is governed - municipalities, county councils and regions

- The Parliament, "Riksdagen", is the supreme political decision-making body in Sweden.
- Sweden is divided into 290 municipalities and 21 county councils/regions.
- There is no hierarchical relation between municipalities, county councils and regions, since all have their own selfgoverning local authorities with responsibility for different activities.

Facts about Stockholm County

- 2 percent of Sweden's area
- Over 2,2 million inhabitants
- 20 percent of Sweden's population
- 30,000–40,000 new inhabitants per year
- Most densely populated county in Sweden
- Half of the county consists of forest, and 30 000 islands
- 26 municipalities



Gender policy and Gender-Based Violence

Domestic violence is a form of discrimination against women

Recommendation 19 in Convention on the elimination on the forms of discrimination against women (CEDAW) The elimination of violence against women involves challenging the unequal division of social, political, and economic power among women and men

The Swedish Gender Equality Policy

That women and men shall have the same power to shape society and their own lives

- Equal division of power and influence
- Economic equality
- Equal education
- Equal distribution of unpaid housework and provision of care
- Equal health
- Men's violence against women must end





National strategy to prevent and combat men's violence against women 2017-2027

- The strategy is laying the foundation for increasingly goal-oriented and coordinated action on men's violence against women.
- Long-term strategy (10 years)
- The strategy also emphasises the participation and responsibility of men in stopping the violence.
- Developing violence prevention measures is particularly important.
- Target groups are government agencies and county councils.
- The 21 County Administrative Boards constitutes the hub for the implementation of strategy in every region




Target groups

- Women and girls exposed to sexual violence regardless of relation to the perpetrator.
- Women and girls* exposed to domestic violence.
- Women and girls* exposed to honorrelated violence and oppression, including child marriages, forced marriages and genital mutilation.
- Women and girls* in prostitution or exploited for sexual purposes.
- Men and boys** who risk or have exposed someone to violence or committed sexual offenses.

*Men and boys and LGBTQ – persons

Increased and effective preventive work to combat violence

Improved detection of violence and stronger protection of and support to women and children subjected to violence

More effective crime-fighting

Improved knowledge and methodological development

We follow up and report on developments in the county






Can we afford to wait?

- Men represent 86-98 procent of the perpertrators in crimestatistics.
- Gender Based Violence costs about 4,4 bilion euros each year in Sweden.
- Preventive measures during childhood and adolescence needs to be a priority.
- We need to work with a Gender Transformative Approach and target the perpetrators and not just the victims.
- We must engage boys and men in gender equality work and involve the whole community in the effort



Levels of prevention











Safe events and festivals



- Everyone should feel safe and secure when visiting a public event without being afraid or worried about being subjected to crime and sexual assaults.
- Cooperation between the police, county administrative board and Svensk LIVE





Mentors in violence prevention



- We promote the development of preventive measures against violence
- The effort is mainly aimed at young people between 0-25 years, ensuring a safe upbringing and opportunities to create healthy, good and loving relationships in their immediate surroundings.
- We support the usage of violence prevention school programs, like MVP (mentor in violence prevention)
- MVP is a manual-based lesson series for schools, aiming to stop and prevent the violence of men and boys.
- Pupils and teachers learn to take responsibility for each other and attract attention if they see or hear violence and violations.

We are in charge of a new pilot project to establish a national helpline offering advice, information and support to help perpetrators stop being violent and abusive to their partners







- "Operation Kvinnofrid"— a regional cooperation platform between agencies to counter Gender — Based violence in Stockholm County.
- Collaborating actors are the Police, the municipalities, the health services, The Swedish Prison and Probation Service and the County Administrative Board.
- We organise an annual conference on Gender-Based Violence
- We award a annual prize to an organisation that has carried out important work in the field of violence prevention
