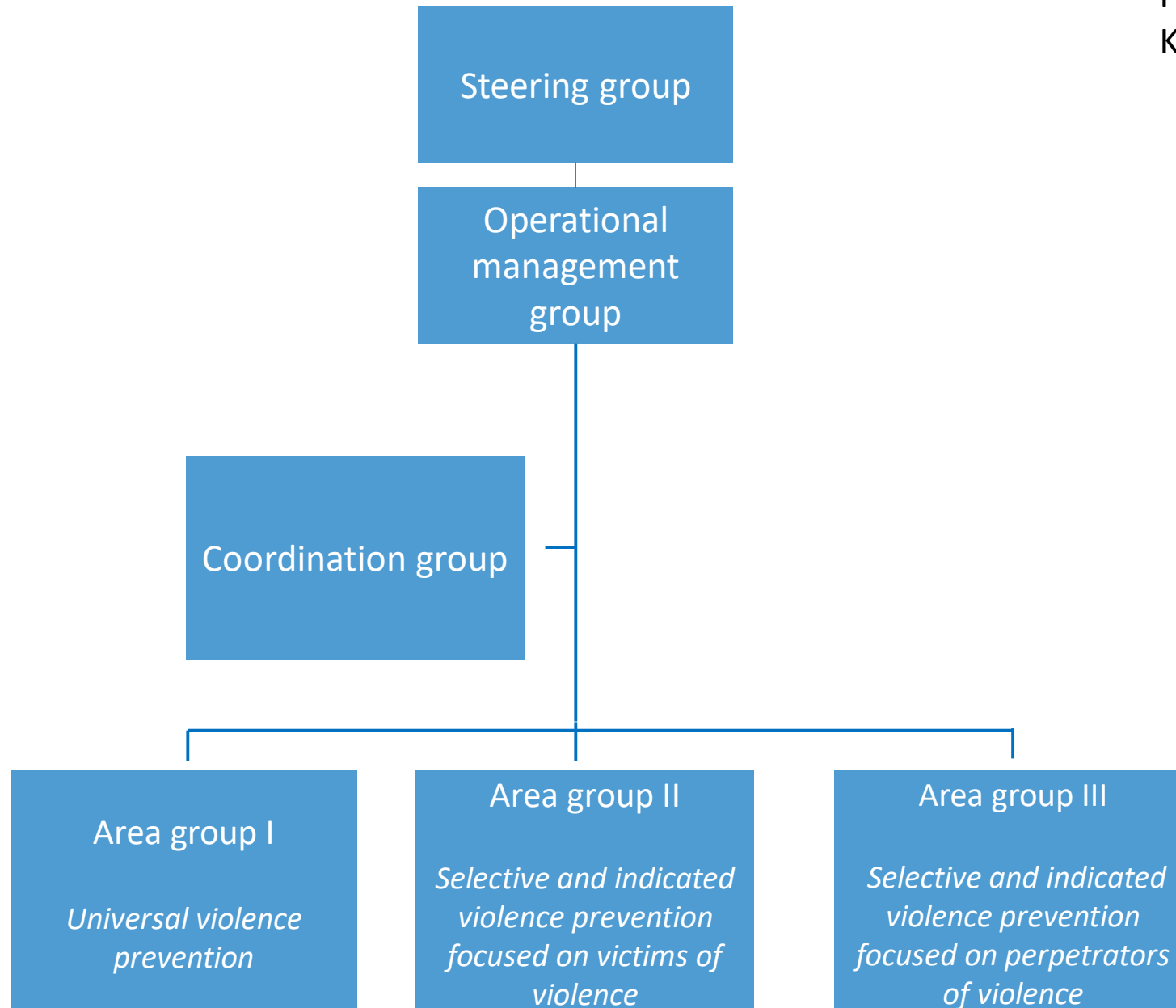

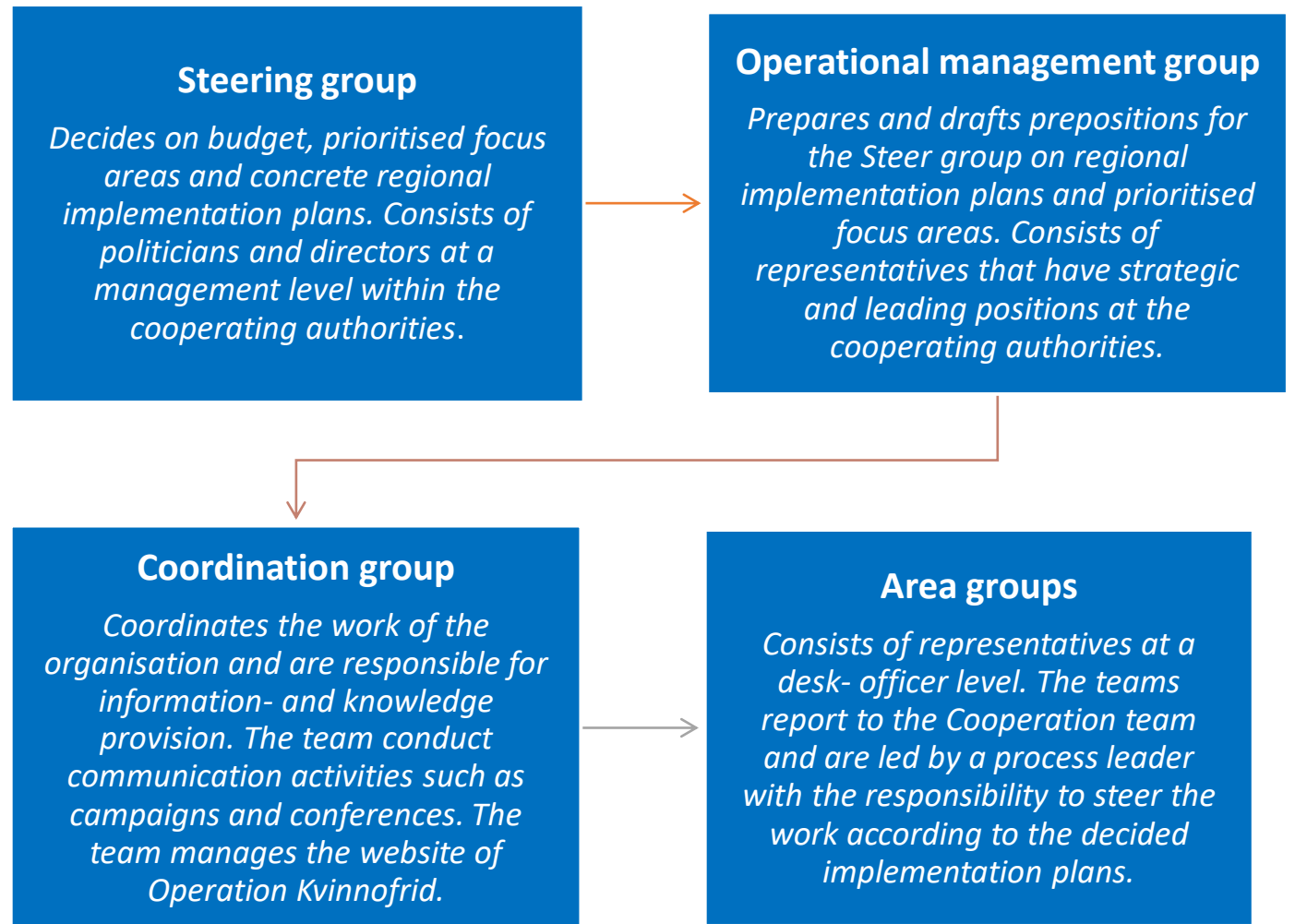

Target Groups

- **Internal actors/ cooperative partners**

- Victims of intimate partner violence

Women and men aged 18 and above, living in heterosexual or same sex relationships as well as victims of other family and extended family related violence such as honour- related violence and oppression.


- Children living with intimate partner violence

Persons under the age of 18. Intimate partner refers to the child's parents/ guardian, siblings, foster parents, step parents as well as extended family.

- Perpetrators of intimate partner violence

Men and women of all ages in heterosexual or same sex relationships as well as in other family and extended family relationships such as honour-related violence and oppression.

Objectives of Operation Kvinnofrid

Long-term objective:

No one in Stockholm County shall be a victim of or experience intimate partner violence (IPV)

Sub- objectives:

1. The public has knowledge of IPV and where to receive help and support
2. There is an ongoing violence preventive work with the cooperation of the non- governmental sector to counteract IPV
3. There is knowledge within the organisations of how to identify potential risks of being exposed to IPV as well as of how to investigate potential need for interventions
4. Adult victims of, and children living with IPV are receiving high-quality interventions based on their needs
5. Perpetrators of IPV are receiving high-quality interventions based on their needs in order for the violence to stop
6. There is a clear structure for cooperation within and among concerned authorities, on an individual as well as structural level

OPERATION KVINNOFRID

- In March 2011, Operation Kvinnofrid assumes a new action plan with a particular focus on honor-related violence and oppression/tyranny
- In 2013, Origo, a project 3 year, was Sweden's first authority-based resource center that provides support to young people who are exposed to, or at risk of, honor-related violence and oppression/tyranny.
- Origo is a result of Operation Kvinnofrid
- Today is Origo no longer a project but a permanent activity

Honor-related violence and oppression is about the requirement that everyone in the family must follow certain rules, in order not to destroy the family's reputation and reputation, its honor.

Any sex or sexual orientation can be subject to honor-related oppression and violence.

Those who live in honor of oppression do not get the freedom that all children and young people are entitled to - we want to put an end to that

- Origo - a cooperation between the municipalities in Stockholm County, the police authority in Stockholm County and Stockholm County Council. The organization consists of a work team of professionals from "different" authorities who cooperate under one roof.
 - 1 chef
 - 1 coordinator
 - 1 policy
 - 1 midwife
 - 4 curators
- Target groups: young persons from 13-26 years
